I Am Not Well Disposed Now; I Will Go Later

Taken from "Confession – A Little Book for the Reluctant"

St. Francis de Sales said, "I am not in the habit of putting off till tomorrow what I can do today." Do you the same; it is a simple rule of good sense, above all when there is a question of serious affairs.

Will you be better prepared tomorrow than today? And later, will you not have the same difficulties as you have now? There will always be the same ice to break, the same self-love to put underfoot; the Confession will cost just as much, perhaps more. The longer a land lies fallow; the harder and more tiresome it is to plow. The longer you leave without cultivation the soil of your conscience, the harder it will become, the more it will be covered with thorns and briars, the greater will be the effort, and it will cost more to restore it to a proper condition. For the love of God and of yourself, do not recoil before the difficulty and do not augment it. Courage, therefore, and do not bargain with God, with your Saviour, who gives you today, in His mercy, the means of returning to Him; who wills only your good and your happiness; who loves you and wills to be loved by you. What happiness can you find in remaining in mortal sin? Are you a Christian? Have you any faith? Are you not afraid to die?
