- Can examples be cited in which John Paul II supported modernists? (continued)

- Who is Hans Urs von Balthasar?

In keeping with the "new theology", Hans Urs von Balthasar (Swiss, 1905-88) devoted himself to reconstructing theology around modern philosophers and poets. Highly influenced by the fake mystic Adrienne von Speyr (1902-67), he also developed the thesis of an empty hell. Named cardinal by John Paul II in 1988, his sudden death prevented him from receiving the cardinal's hat.

- Who is Walter Kasper?

President (since 2001) of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, Walter Kasper is notwithstanding a declared enemy of the Catholic Faith. In his book *Jesus the Christ*, he openly denies many miracles recounted in the Gospels: "We must count as legendary many of the stories of miracles contained in the Gospels. In these legends one must seek not so much their historical content as their theological aim." He doubts the historicity of the Resurrection: "This observation of the existence of an historical core in the accounts concerning the tomb in no way implies a proof in favor of the resurrection." He also goes so far as to put in doubt our Lord's divinity, writing pages and pages to relativize all the scriptural passages that mention it. Nevertheless, Kasper was named cardinal by John Paul II in 2001 without having retracted any of his theses.

- Does Benedict XVI also back these modernist theologians

On September 24, 2005, Benedict XVI received in a private audience for several hours the heretical theologian Hans Kung, whom John Paul II had always refused to receive because of his revolt against the Church's magisterium. In October 2005, he praised Hans Urs von Balthasar at a conference honoring this modernist theologian. [60] In May 2007, he authorized the International Theological Commission to publish a document calling in question the Church's doctrine on purgatory.

- Hasn't Benedict XVI been trying to appoint conservative bishops?

Several of Benedict XVI's appointments are disastrous.

- Archbishop William Levada, appointed prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith in 2005, used to cover up homosexual priests in his successive dioceses in the United States. He is one of the most ecumenical prelates of that country. He was the first American bishop to visit a synagogue, and he hosted events in his cathedral in "the spirit of Assisi", in which Jews, Muslims, Buddhists, Hindus, etc., participated. He also declared that transubstantiation is "a long and difficult word" that "we no longer use."
- Msgr. George Niederauer, named archbishop of San Francisco, is openly a friend of homosexuals. He was publicly praised for this by Same Sinnet and Francis DeBernardo, presidents of homosexual groups.
- Msgr. Odilo Pedro Scherer, named archbishop of Sao Paul on March 21, 2007, was previously the secretary general of the very progressive Brazilian Episcopal Conference.
