ABORTION IN NEW ZEALAND

Today, 94 members of Parliament voted for a radical bill that attempts to remove any legal recognition or protection of the unborn child, and introduces one of the most radical abortion laws in the world. The following is a letter written by Fr Laisney, sent to all MP's of the New Zealand Government letting them know of his opposition to decriminalising abortion. Dear (name of MP),

The most beautiful thing in the world is a Mother's Love for her child. And it is rewarded by the second beautiful thing in the world, a child's love for his/her mother! This is one of the deepest inclinations of human heart, and the foundation of so many other values.

Abortion destroys that. It kills not only the baby in the womb, but also the heart of the mother. If a mother can kill her baby in her womb, what other crime will she fear? What man can trust such a woman? And what woman can trust a man who wants her to destroy the fruit of their love? It is the whole gamut of human relations that is destroyed by abortion. Abortion is undoubtedly the epitome of modern evils. How could it be "decriminalised"? If that is not a crime, then nothing else is a crime. There are no more public morals, the only rule that remains is to try "to get away with" whatever one does – no matter how evil.

We acknowledge of course that there are sometimes difficult situations in which women find themselves because of pregnancies. But abortion is NEVER the solution, certainly never the right solution to such situation. These women do need help, but abortion is not a help at all: not only does it kill the baby, but it wounds the mother deeply – for a whole life. There are OTHER solutions, true solutions, and these must be promoted; decriminalising abortion does not promote them at all. It is a selfish, apparently "easy" solution, that brings much more problems and evils than it solves. It would be an awful shame for New Zealand. Please, protect New Zealand from this!

Last but not least, those who are responsible for abortions (that includes MPs who vote for them – and MPs are responsible for ALL the abortions done under the laws that they have voted for) do prepare unto themselves a frightful place at the Last Judgement, when they will hear "whatsoever you have done to the least of mine, to Me you did it." Spare your soul, vote against abortion!
