GOD THE HOLY GHOST

The Gifts of the Holy Ghost in General.

In the hierarchy of virtues in the supernatural life, the highest are called the Gifts of the Holy Ghost, whose existence we know only by Faith. Isaias tells us that the Holy Ghost reposing in our souls creates sublime sentiments and completes in them the moral world, just as He completed the physical world by breathing over the waters. The Holy Spirit is essentially a perfecting power. He puts, as it were, the finishing touches, the supreme seal on all the works of God. He could not, then, but intervene in the great work of our sanctification. This he has done by infusing grace, the virtues and His Gifts. These latter are permanent qualities to which that beautiful Name has been given, because they are so to speak the presents, the gifts par excellence of the love of the Creator His creature.

The general aim or objective of the Gifts is to place us at the disposal of God, and to make us docile to all His inspirations. God uses our conscience and our reason to lead us. They regulate all, even the theological virtues. But since God is a being, absolute and transcendent, He can and does give to creatures as how He pleases, direct impulses. Particularly does He use His absolute authority in human life. He has souls enter into pathways of His choosing; He invites them according to the decisions of His wisdom, to speak or to be silent, to halt or advance, to action or to contemplation. He sometimes demands that we renounce our own thoughts, ideas, plans; follow and adopt those that He suggests; leave one path and walk along the one He pleases; abandon ourselves for an hour, a day, a lifetime to His idea.
