Instruction for Confirmation

This coming Sunday, 2 August, is a great day of grace for our confirmands and for our parish.

At 9:30 A.M., there will be a “Check-in” for Confirmands and Sponsors: Please be on time. That means arriving in the primary school by 9:30 A.M., having already found parking, toilets, etc.

At 9:45 A.M., all Confirmands, and their Sponsors beside them, are to be in the seat assigned to them in the church preparing for the sacrament that they are about to receive. Men & Boys on the Gospel side and Ladies and Girls on the Epistle side. ***No confirmands are to leave during the ceremony itself, to assure the integrity of the sacrament. The men will receive the sacrament first, with the conditional confirmation going last in their group, the women will then receive Confirmation, again with the conditional confirmations going last in their group.***

Seating for Family and Friends: The families and friends of the confirmands are cordially invited to find seating only after the Confirmands and their sponsors have seating.

Group Photo: There will be a group photo with Bishop Goldade and the confirmands (not the sponsors) outside the Church after the Mass (We will supply a photographer).

genuflect and kiss his ring when he offers it. The proper title by which to address him is: “My Lord,” or “Your Excellency.”

Mass: Follows the Confirmation ceremony.

Celebration: After the ceremony there will be a celebration only for the confirmands and immediate family in the Primary school. Please bring a plate to share.

Dress Code for Confirmation Men and Boys

Formal, long trousers. Long-sleeved dress shirt, if not wearing a jacket. A neck tie or bow tie is also required.

Women and Girls

A white dress is recommended but not obligatory. Otherwise, Sunday-best. A mantilla, preferably white, is required. Dresses must cover the knees when sitting and must have sleeves at least down to the elbow. Since the confirmands must go up the steps of the sanctuary to kneel in front of the bishop, please do not wear high heels.

For All

As the bishop will be laying his hand on the head of the Confirmand and anointing them on the forehead, it is requested that as much hair as possible be combed back, away from the forehead; ladies should pin hair up and are asked to be careful their mantillas do not overhang the forehead (hats are not recommended).
